

BECOME CERTIFIED WITH THE ICA

ICA CERTIFIED CPTED PRACTITIONER - ICCP

The ICCP program is the first internationally developed program that recognizes and certifies individual CPTED Practitioners. This program includes 12 units of core competencies that applicants must meet to be certified as a CPTED Practitioner through the ICA.

Certification starts with an application to the certification board. You then create your own log book documenting projects that satisfy ICCP competencies. Finally, you complete an examination tailored to your own professional experience.

Certification is a way to clearly indicate to your employer, your clients and your colleagues that you are qualified and prepared to perform the duties expected of a competent, professional CPTED practitioner.

GET YOUR COURSE ICA ACCREDITED

COURSE ACCREDITATION PROGRAM - CAP

CPTED instructors or course developers can now receive ICA accreditation as an “approved ICA CPTED course”. Courses with CAP status gain professional recognition by the ICA as having satisfied key units of core CPTED competency. Students completing an ICA accredited course receive accelerated status when applying for individual ICCA certification.

All CPTED course instructors or developers may submit their course for CAP status. Accreditation starts with an application to the CAP Review Board at Class A or B levels. Applications will include documentation of course curricula, evaluation methods, and lesson plans. Applicants must be full members of the ICA and instructors of Class A courses must be ICCP certified.

Once approved from the CAP Review Board, the accredited course is enrolled in the ICA Course Accreditation Program at the Class A or Class B level. Class A is full course accreditation and approves a CPTED course for 8 core competencies; Class B is partial course accreditation and approves a CPTED course for a limited number of core competencies.

The ICA CAP program represents a new level of professionalism in the CPTED world.
